Cross Country 2023 (Regionals & Championship)

- Three (3) school buses at a total cost of  $\$75.00 \times 3 = \$254.25$  (tax included)

**Total Cost Potential Costs for Cross Country Season:**

**\$254.25 (tax included)**

Girls Volleyball

- \$64.00 for tournament fee at West Regional playoffs
- \$40.00 for interschool tournament registration fee
- 1 half day supply coverage for coaches at total cost of \$118.40

\*The girls' team will hold a tournament this school year to try to offset some of the costs.

**Total Cost Potential Costs for Girls Volleyball Season:**

**\$222.00**

Track & Field (Regionals & Championships)

- 1/2 supply teachers for full day coverage
  - o 2 Full day coverage for teacher at the Reginal meet at a total cost of \$473.50 (236.75 x 2)
  - o 1/2 teacher for the TVDSB Championships at a total cost of \$118.40 (TVDSB will cover 0.5 of the supply cost).
